

#### PROGRAM "EUROPE FOR CITIZENS"

The Europe for Citizens Program is an important instrument to make the Union's 500 million inhabitants play a more active role in the Union's development, By funding projects and activities in which citizens can participate, the program it promotes com-mon European history and values and fosters a sense of involvement in the way the Union evolves.
